Footnotes

LAVIN'S BLUFF settled off the pace off the rail, started a drive into the final turn, took aim at the rail entering the stretch, dueled for control a sixteenth away and dug in gamely to last. CORDIAL LADY angled over for inside position to set the pace, rated between horses through the backstretch, continued to contest the final turn two deep and dueled gamely to earn place while outfinished for the win. ROCK A TONG stalked the pace inside, dueled at the rail with a slim disadvantage through the final turn, had the lead at the top of the lane and continued gamely to deep stretch though was outfinished from the sixteenth pole. MONTANA TRAIL stalked the pace three wide, contested a slim lead leaving the quarter pole, lost ground and the lead entering the stretch but quickly recovered stride and finished evenly. GATEWAY BREAK, unhurried toward mid track, bid saving ground into the final turn and finished well. HOT HONEYMOON rated off the pace about the four path then leveled off through the lane. MARK UP TINY was outrun. LIPSOFANANGEL stalked the pace about the four path the opening turn then faded on the final turn. PRICE OF FREEDOM was outrun saving ground.
