Footnotes

ANNA'S FIREBALL rated a short lead inside, came under pressure from the five sixteenths pole and held well with steady encouragement. RUTLEDGE STAR stalked the pace off the rail, picked up the chase past the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly for a clear place finish. PRIDE OF MARY settled off the early pace about the three path, bid from the three eighths pole, saved ground through the final turn and ran evenly in the stretch. LONG SHADOW, unhurried outside, bid into the final turn then leveled off through the lane. HIGHNTHESKYMERCURY settled unhurriedly toward mid track, bid angling widest on the final turn and had nothing further in the stretch. MR. KNOCK OUT chased the early pace off the rail then lacked a response on the final turn. DANGER ANGEL was not a factor. WILD MAMBO rated close to the early pace inside then weakened rounding the final turn.
