ROUGH TIME, carried outward through the opening turn, rated a short lead off the rail down the backstretch, came under a drive nearing the head of the lane and dug in to hold well. ONEWILDRIVER settled off the early pace off the rail, eased toward mid track with a bid nearing the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn in the four path and dueled to get up for place the closing strides. TAKELA SHAM rated back toward the outside, bid leaving the half mile pole, rounded the final turn six wide then outfinished for place while just up for show. OMEGA SUPREME, a step slow to break, rated just off the early pace about the four path, improved past the three eighths pole, was under a drive two deep past the quarter but leveled off in the stretch. ROADHOUSE ROMEO gave chase inside to the quarter pole before leveling off. MR BEAR, well off the pace toward mid track, was carried outward rounding the final turn and had nothing further down the lane. ROVIN GAMBLER, briefly close, dropped back steadying the opening turn and was not a factor. TOTALLY CHARMING rated a slim early lead off the rail, drifted outward on the opening turn, was caught near the half mile pole, corrected course down the backstretch then drifted outward on the final turn as well.
