Footnotes

CATEGORY THREE led throughout on a clear lead, prevailed under steady urging. LIL MISS JANE pressed the pace three wide, could not gain on the winner while second best. I JUST DID IT went to her nose at the start, moved up five wide and finished strongly. KNOBIE prompted the issue from the rail, eased out three wide on the turn, lacked a late response. ROCKY'S ANGEL stalked the leaders three wide, failed to respond. VIRGINIA WEST broke in a tangle, saved ground but had no rally. GLENORIE off a step slow, saved ground, steadied in the upper stretch while not a threat. VIRGINIA HARBOUR made little impact, three and four wide. COWGIRL SASS showed little, five wide.
