**Footnotes**

MISS SUGARMAGNOLIA settled close to the early pace inside, eased three wide with a bid toward the quarter pole, took control into the stretch, dueled clear from there and held well. WAY POINT rated a short lead inside, came under pressure near the five sixteenths pole, maintained slim control through the final turn but yielded into the stretch and leveled off from the sixteenth pole. GILDED ROYALE stalked the early pace two deep, moved to even terms at the three eighths pole, had a brief slim lead a pole later, gave close chase from that point but weakened at the top of the lane. PARADE SONG, well back inside, made a mild bid near the rail leaving the quarter pole but had nothing further in the lane. SALSA PRIDE was no factor while saving ground. SPRINGTIME FROLIC was no factor outside.
