Footnotes

THUNDERELLO DANCER angled in leaving the gate, lugged across the path of Please Don't early on getting his heels clipped, rated a clear lead inside, came under some pressure near the quarter pole then moderately handled through the lane to widen. GENERAL LAD checked early to avoid a fallen rider, stalked the pace off the rail, picked up the chase past the three eighths pole, faltered under a hard drive and settled for second best. ALEXANDER'S COWBOY checked early to avoid a fallen rider, raced in the five path entering the first turn, corrected course to give chase off the rail through the backstretch, was shut off steadying at the quarter pole, eased three wide into the lane and finished evenly in show. GALLO, awkward at the break, was carried extremely wide by the loose horse on the first turn, came inside of that one to resume his chase in mid track leaving the turn, saved some ground on the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. LUMINOUS TIMES, pinched back at the break, jumped a fallen rider early, settled well back of the pace off the rail, made a bid from the quarter pole and finished evenly. TIME IS NOW was forced outward while in tight between horses early, chased the pace off the rail on the backstretch, moved to the inside at the quarter pole but had little left in the stretch. BEE A WINNER steadied while angling outward to avoid a fallen rider early, gave chase inside then faded on the backstretch. CHESTNUT PRIZE broke in and raced well back. KOKO KEY was shut off steadying a few strides from the gate, moved to the outside early to avoid the mishap in front of him then not encouraged past the opening quarter. PLEASE DON'T was shut off and clipped the heels of Thunderello Dancer causing his rider to become unseated early. After posting the inquiry, the stewards disqualified Thunderello Dancer to last place for angling in too early causing Please Don't to clip heels and lose his rider.
