Footnotes

DARKE ICE settled off the early pace in the two path, rallied four wide around the far turn, took command turning for home and drove clear. ZAMITA was off slow, lagged inside, angled three wide approaching the far turn, angled back to the rail near the three-sixteenths pole and rallied inside to gain the place. SO LOVELY stalked the pace three wide, led from the quarter pole to eighth pole and weakened through the lane. DANCING AT NICKIES saved ground and failed to menace. JACKPOT JANET bobbed at the start, stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, moved to the front near the three-eighths pole and tired around the far turn. GROOVIN POINT saved ground and played no factor. EIGHT GIG NANO set the pace along the rail and faltered after a half. RACINGMOLLYGREEN was outrun while racing three wide.
