Footnotes

BIG JIMMY J. rated a clear lead inside the opening turn, came under pressure to chase the runner-up from the three eighths pole and dug in under determined stretch handling to get up the final yards. GOLD RAPTOR raced boxed at the heels of the winner through the first turn, moved out a path to take a slim lead two deep at the three eighths pole, edged clear toward the final turn, was under a drive into the stretch but caught the final yards. SILVER MAPLE settled off the pace about the three path, bid saving ground at the three eighths pole, improved near the rail through the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. TEQUILA MAX, well back outside, bid approaching the three eighths pole, closed in the four path rounding the final turn and finished evenly. ANNA'S FIREBALL settled back toward the inside and had no rally. FREE HUMOR rated close to the early pace about the four path then faded through the backstretch. STORMIN' YANKEE stalked the early pace in the three path, had aim at the half mile pole then faded after a half mile.
