SIR SILVER FOX prompted the issue from the rail, angled out for the drive, caught THE JACKAL in late stretch and drove clear. THE JACKAL dueled on a slim lead down the backstretch, opened a clear lead into the stretch, led until late stretch before giving way to the winner while clearly second best. DANCENSING pressed the pace three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. LOVE TO THE MAX forced the issue inside, tried to rally around the turn four wide, came up empty in the drive. MR. LADIES MAN broke awkwardly but quickly moved up to stalk the leaders three wide, came five wide on the turn, lacked the needed late rally. AUSTIN LAVIVA BABY three wide along the backstretch, angled to the rail on the turn, finished willingly through the drive.
