Footnotes

FLATWOOD HANK rated a short lead inside, came under pressure toward the quarter pole, lost some ground entering the stretch then lugged inward under steady right hand insistence and held well to the wire. ALBERS came out early, settled back toward the outside, bid from the three eighths pole, took aim three wide at the top of the stretch and closed steadily to get place the final stride. SHAMSS settled off the pace inside, took aim at the rail through the final turn, duelled close from the top of the stretch, was shut off from the sixteenth pole to the wire and missed place as a result. ICE BERLIN settled off the pace inside, angled outward on the final turn, entered the stretch five wide and finished well. DR. FINNEGAN stalked the early pace off the rail, lacked a response on the final turn then leveled off in the stretch. CANAVERAL DANCER, off the pace about the three path, was pressured toward the quarter pole but showed little response on the final turn. FOR APPEAL was no factor while saving ground. SHAMELESS RISK was no factor inside. PINE BROOK, a step slow to break, stumbled after the start. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of third place finisher Shamss, and disqualified the former for interfering with the latter through the final sixteenth.
