GROSSO rated close inside, made her bid off the rail nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch four wide, dueled to the front a sixteenth away then steadily encouraged to draw clear. ROCKING LADY settled back inside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, angled five wide leaving the final turn, got up late for place and finished well. KELLY IRISH GIRL rated a short lead inside, came under pressure toward the quarter pole, contested the rail on the final turn, dug in with a slim lead in the upper stretch then lugged inward while leveling off the last sixteenth. CONGRESIONALAFFAIR stalked the pace two deep, challenged the pacesetter through the final turn but dropped back into the lane and flattened stride from the sixteenth pole. EXPLOSIVE STAR rated off the early pace three wide, bid from the quarter pole, saved ground through the final turn, closed to midstretch but was shut off and checked past the sixteenth pole. PRINCESS SUSAN M, well back and outside, ran seven wide on the final turn then weakened through the lane. WATERSIDE ROSE raced well back saving ground. LATIKA rated close to the early pace two deep, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole then faded four wide on the final turn.
