Footnotes

GOLD SCORE disputed the early pace three wide between rivals around the first turn, settled off DADDYROE while still racing between rivals down the backstretch, bid two wide between foes around the far turn, reached even terms near the three-sixteenths pole, dueled between past the sixteenth pole, dueled inside of JOSIAH through the final sixteenth and prevailed in a game effort. JOSIAH stalked the pace five wide around the first turn, bid three deep into the far turn, reached near even terms approaching the three-sixteenths pole, dueled outside of the winner from there to the wire and was denied. DADDYROE steadied while in tight early, advanced inside around the first turn, moved three wide between rivals to take the lead near the half-mile pole, went clear near the three-eighths pole, vied inside of the top two from the three-sixteenths marker to midstretch and weakened in the final sixteenth. TWENTY HAWKS chased the pace three and four wide and lacked a rally. HOLY WATERS lacked speed, advanced six wide around the first turn, gained outside down the backstretch and tired while racing four wide around the far turn. HAMMERING BUCKEYE failed to menace while racing three and four wide. IM A TIGGER TOO set the early pace in the two path, dropped back down the backstretch and continued to fade inside around the far turn.
