VIOLANDA dueled on a slim lead, drew clear around the turn but was all out to last. ELUSIVE ASHLEE forced the pace from the rail, angled out for the drive and finished strongly. LIMO AND LUNCH saved ground, rallied four wide on the turn, closed with a rush. DEER CREEK LADY stalked the pace from the rail, lacked a closing bid. CALAMIAMINE three wide down the backstretch, moved to the rail around the turn, lacked the needed rally. MILADYS A PROSPECT pressed the pace just off the rail, lacked a late response. T. V. SECRETARY prompted the pace three and four wide, lacked a late bid. BAYJUR was used up after a half three wide. HUGS FOR TERRY stumbled just after the start then showed little.
