Footnotes

COLONEL J W rated off the pace about the four path, started his drive inside the quarter pole, dueled for control a furlong away and edged clear past the sixteenth. STRAIGHT THUNDER was boxed near the rail leaving the first turn, settled off the pace off the rail through most of the backstretch, made a four wide bid nearing the quarter pole and finished well for place. WILD PROOF rated the pace inside, was pressured at the rail on the final turn and remained a close factor to the sixteenth pole before yielding. IN BROAD DAYLIGHT stalked the pace off the rail, contested between horses on the final turn, dropped back approaching the head of the lane and weakened from there. YOU ARE REAL rated close inside, was boxed at the rail approaching the final turn then lacked a response through the turn. SPEEDY TUXEDO and PUNK ROBINSON were outrun. SHALLOW FORD kept aim the opening half mile then faded.
