Footnotes

HOT TRIPPI settled off the pace off the rail, made a four wide bid toward the five sixteenths pole, took over three wide midway on the final turn then kept to a steady drive to widen. KIPLING BOY rated with the pace inside, was pressured toward the five sixteenths pole, contested the rail on the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. CLEAR REASON kept just off the early pace about the three path, made a bid leaving the three eighths pole, had range through the final turn but leveled off in the stretch. CAROLINE'S DANCER, off the pace inside, bid at the five sixteenths pole though had little left in the stretch. ESTRELLA CORREDOR rated a slim lead two deep, came under pressure leaving the five sixteenths pole, was caught while between horses midway through the final turn and weakened in the stretch. STONE DANCER, well back early, made a bid leaving the three sixteenths pole and passed tired rivals at the rail. NIK'S STAR CHOICE was outrun in the three and four paths. PLEASANT GALLOP and WE SHALL BE LUCKY quickly lost contact.
