**Footnotes**

COUNT YOUR PENNIES rated close to the early pace inside, bid past the three eighths pole, eased three wide leaving the final turn, dug in for the lead late yards and edged clear toward the wire. HAPPY REFRAIN stalked the pace two deep, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, held aim through the final turn, dug in to even terms between horses in late stretch, was outfinished from there but held on for place. SILK SLIPPER settled well back off the rail, bid nearing the five sixteenths pole, closed with a rush along the rail through the stretch, angled between horses late to get third and was gaining on the runner-up in a strong finish. RUN RAVEN RUN moved to the lead inside approaching the five eighths pole after stumbling from the gate and making contact with Precious Cargo, rated the pace through the backstretch, came under pressure toward the quarter pole and dug in with the advantage to late stretch before weakening. SECRET MILLIONAIRE, bumped early, settled off the pace toward mid track, started a bid leaving the three eighths pole and improved steadily rounding the final turn before leveling off. HIDDEN BLUFF settled well back outside, improved off the rail rounding the final turn but weakened while losing ground into the lane. EXPENSIVE GIFT was no factor saving ground. PRECIOUS CARGO, jostled early, rated close to the early pace off the rail, eased toward the outside leaving the half mile pole then weakened nearing the final turn. ALWAYS REGENT rated close toward mid track, gave chase leaving the half mile pole then gave way nearing the final turn.
