**Footnotes**

AARON'S WAY set the pace outside down the backstretch, inched clear while racing in the two path around the turn, angled to the rail once clear nearing the lane then drew clear under a steady drive. KING OF SCOTTLAND lacked speed down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the turn, drifted in slightly in upper stretch drifted out under left-handed urging through the final sixteenth, never switched leads and finished evenly. ROBB'S WARRIOR stalked the pace three wide, raced between rivals through the lane and won the battle for the show. GATOR DONE advanced along the rail down the backstretch to briefly pressure the winner nearing the turn, chased that foe from the rail around the bend and weakened a bit in the drive. ALLEN'S MONSTER threw his head just before the start and was off a step slow, raced four and five wide around the turn and lacked the needed stretch rally. SARATOGA DANCING chased the pace three wide and tired. The rider of GATOR DONE claimed foul against the winner, alleging interference around the turn, but the Stewards found no reason for disqualification.
