**Footnotes**

BIG RED RIVER came away awkwardly and in, was urged to contention to give chase two deep, dueled to the front in midstretch and inched clear toward the wire. KIPPY KAT, edgy in the gate, was urged clear to set the pace three wide, drifted outward in the upper stretch then leveled off when straightened away. BLUE TAPE, jostled at the break, chased the pace about the three path and finished evenly. MONTY'S APPEAL was rank leaving the gate, gave distant chase outside, entered the stretch six wide and finished evenly. LORD PARKER, reluctant to load, chased the pace from the inside, was pinched back at the rail approaching the turn though recovered mildly in the lane. BAI THE CAT chased the early pace two deep, angled toward the rail nearing the turn but had nothing further through the turn. PEACE BUSTER was hustled to contention inside and raced a close factor to the head of the lane before fading. TIC TAC MAN engaged in close early chase toward the outside but faded on the turn. SHOT GUN EDDIE L was jostled and shut off at the break and dropped well back.
