Footnotes

RUTLEDGE LION was kept in range of the early pace toward mid track, started a bid at the five sixteenths pole, dug in three wide from the top of the stretch to take the lead a sixteenth away and was inching ahead toward the wire. BETTER STEP ASIDE rated close to the early pace three wide, bid from the five sixteenths pole, took the lead past the quarter, raced clear in mid turn then held a slight advantage leaving the eighth pole before grudgingly ceding the final sixteenth. CLARKE COUNTY rated close to the early pace two deep, checked at the heels of the waning pacesetter leaving the quarter pole, came around that one through the turn, was apprehensively ridden behind an opening in flux in midstretch, eased out late but couldn't regain momentum. PREMIER'S WHINNY settled outside down the backstretch, bid from the five sixteenths pole, saved some ground on the turn, eased to mid track at the head of the lane and finished evenly. IN CONFIDENCE saved ground well back of the pace, made a mild bid off the rail on the final turn but leveled out in the stretch. TOUGH TALKING dwelt several lengths at the start, settled back of the early pace off the rail then incrementally improved from the opening turn. TITAN LAUNCH rated the pace inside, came under pressure at the five sixteenths pole, gave chase after being caught past the quarter pole but weakened in the stretch. DEFINITE HUMOR was not a factor. WHITE POST rated close to the early pace inside then faded through the backstretch. GUNGA DAN stalked

the early pace two deep though gave way after a half mile.
