DOC'S TZER pressed the issue from just off the rail, made the lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch under a strong urging. JADEITE knocked sideways at the start, moved up three and four wide and finished well. KALIK YOUR HEELS set the pace along the rail, dug in around the turn, weakened in the drive. QUOIT A DINNER off the pace four wide, rallied around the turn but failed to sustain his bid. DR. BARCH off a step slow then bore out, was wide into the first turn, dropped down to be with the pace three wide, had no late bid. NAPOLEON J sluggish at the start, stalked the leaders along the inside, had no response in the lane. ASK COURT forced the issue three wide, lacked the needed rally. HE'S A ROCKET MAN close up on the rail for a half, fell back around the turn. SHRINKS bore in at the start and soundly bumped with QUIET PRIVATEER, showed little. QUIET PRIVATEER tardy at the start then soundly bumped, trailed.
