COUNT BRAHMS broke out, stalked the pace inside, assumed the lead approaching the quarter pole, dueled clear into the stretch and held on well with steady encouragement. WIREBUSTER broke in, closed toward contention through the backstretch, started his drive into the final turn and dueled for place. PARKER'SGOLDENCAT angled over to take the lead and position just off the rail to set the pace, contested the final turn two deep, lost a path entering the stretch and dug in gamely at the winner's flank through the lane, though yielded to that one and was ultimately outfinished in the duel for place. FIRST AND BAY, a step slow to break, rated off the pace about the three path and made a mild bid through the lane. LEGAL PAD stalked the pace three wide, made his bid bearing the quarter pole then leveled off through the lane. FORBES was not a factor. LIL MARVIN, forced out at the break, chased the pace from the inside before fading on the final turn. RUNAGAINSTTHERULES came away a step slow and was pinched back at the start.
