VICARIOUS MOON set the pace along the rail, drew off around the far turn and widened under a steady drive drive through the lane. JEWEL'S FROLIC bumped with DON'T SHORT MARIA after the start, saved some ground toward the rear of the field, swung four wide midway around the first turn, advanced four wide around the far turn and finished well to gain the place. BREADMAN'S HONEY was unhurried while three wide around the first turn, advanced down the backstretch, continued three wide between rivals around the far turn to move into second then flattened out in the lane. PORCH SITTING stalked the pace in the two path, could not match strides with the winner around the far turn and was out finished for the pace while racing inside of rivals in the lane. IMVROS AFFAIR stalked the pace from the rail, steadied near the nine-sixteenths pole, continued to save ground to the stretch but lacked the needed rally. YOURTEEPPEORMINE was caught four wide around the first turn, advanced down the backstretch, angled toward the rail nearing the far turn and faded. DON'T SHORT MARIA was soundly bumped after the start, saved ground early, raced four wide around the far turn and never threatened. BAL DU BOIS BELLE flashed brief speed along the rail.
