Footnotes

IMMORTAL EYES rated close inside, lacked room rounding the turn, came through an opening at the rail voided by the pacesetting runner-up, was soon in clear command and maintained with aggressive hand urging and rein slapping. YUKON WILDCAT took over leaving the chute to set a fast pace off the rail, lost ground making light contact with Who's Big Daddy entering the stretch, was caught a furlong from the wire but dug in to retain place after yielding to the winner. WHO'S BIG DADDY pressed the pace two deep, was brushed entering the stretch but finished well at the girth of the runner-up. LOVE'S STRONG HART settled off the pace toward mid track, made a five wide bid midway on the turn and finished well outside. BIG GRANDPA pressured the early pace three wide, continued four wide through the turn, angled in at the head of the lane and leveled off from there. ASHBURTON GROVE chased the pace toward mid track then leveled off through the turn. U BOAT ALLEY chased the pace off the rail then faded toward the turn. ALL MYSELF lacked speed while giving distant chase.
