DAILY EXPRESS slammed sideways at the start, pressed the pace, drew off through the stretch under a drive. LENNOXWOOD prompted the issue three wide and was easily second best. CREVE COEUR set the pace on the rail, dug in along the backstretch, gave way around the turn. BOLDEST HEART forced the issue from the inside, lacked a late response. TRUE YIELD soundly bumped at the start, saved ground, lacked the needed rally. DAZZEL 'EM INDY well placed on the rail, had no rally. NASTRO AZZURRO bore in and soundly bumped with TRUE YIELD at the start then was no factor, four wide. ROCK POWDER had little left after a half, five wide. STILL THE ONE stopped after a half on the rail.
