STAKES Blue and Gold S. Listed - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE YEARS OLD. Free nominations. \$250 to pass the entry box, with a guaranteed purse of \$100,000. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 will be accepted by time of closing of entries, all fees included. Entries close Wednesday April 13, 2011, by the usual time of closing. Weight 123 lbs. Non winners of a sweepstakes in 2011 allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of \$30,000 since March 1, 2011 allowed 5 lbs., such a race in 2011 allowed 7 lbs, non-winners of a race other than maiden or claiming in 2011 allowed 9 lbs. Field will be limited to tenstarters with four on the alternates list. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), then stakes winners, then highest lifetime earnings. Nominations close Wednesday April 6, 2011. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

LORANGER NATIVE settled in the two path, made a slight gain when roused midway down the backstretch, came three wide around the far turn, seemed to flattened out while continuing on his left lead in upper stretch, switched leads near the sixteenth pole and closed resolutely under left-handed urging through the final sixteenth to get up in deep stretch. DISKI DANCE stalked the pace three and four wide through the opening half, bid three wide entering the far turn, took a slim lead at the quarter pole, dueled outside of GATORS CHOICE from the quarter pole to the sixteenth pole, edged ahead of that foe inside the sixteenth pole but could not resist the winner in the final strides. GATORS CHOICE set the pace along the rail, was collared at the quarter pole, dueled inside of DISKI DANCE from there to midstretch then gave way grudgingly. PICK FOUR prompted the pace two wide, dropped back leaving the quarter pole, swung four wide midway around the far turn and finished willingly. GO MAIRE TU trailed along the rail.
