MISSLE DO gained a slim lead down the backstretch, drew off ton the urn, widened under urging. PLUCKY DISCOVERY rallied five wide around the turn to be second best. SHE'S A DEPUTY saved ground, bid three wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. LOCKET prompted the pace inside, lacked a late response. MELEIUM stalked the pace inside, failed to respond. WE BOTH WALK set the pace for a half, kept pace along the backstretch, gave way around the turn. POMERANZE (IRE) forced the pace three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. NO NO RENE saved ground to no avail. OAK RUN showed little three wide. SWEET BLISS was used up after three quarters.
