LOST LENORE settled off the pace off the rail, started her bid four wide into the final turn, came between horses for the lead at the sixteenth pole and dug in determinedly to get the nod. HOLY STONE rated off the pace outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, took the lead midway on the final turn, lost some ground entering the stretch, continued to drift outward under a stout left hand drive in midstretch and was outfinished when straightened away. IDONTGETOUTMUCH stalked the pace two deep the opening turn, took the lead nearing the half mile pole, contested the rail on the final turn and dueled close to the sixteenth pole before giving way. COASTAL PARADISE, unhurried inside, angled out through the final turn and finished evenly outside. METS MAGIC raced off the pace about the three path and lacked sufficient response on the final turn. BARBIE'S Q T BEAR was outrun. STEPHSKI was hustle to the early lead for position on the rail the opening turn but gave way beyond the half mile pole. FANTASTIC REVIEW rated off the pace off the rail, faded on the final turn, was eased in the stretch, appeared to be sore and vanned off post race.
