Footnotes

SIR SILVER FOX forced the pace four wide along the backstretch, rallied three wide around the turn, joined AWHOLENEWBALLGAME in mid stretch, was forced out by that one the last sixteenth but prevailed on the wire. AWHOLENEWBALLGAME pressed the issue between horses just off the rail down the backstretch, drifted in some in the upper stretch with the rider switching to the left hand whip, was lugging out the last sixteenth while gaining a momentary lead in deep stretch, missed in a strong effort. TOMAC set the pace from the rail while under heavy pressure, dug in when challenge in the upper stretch, finished gamely but came up short at the end. RAINBOW INTHESTORM prompted the issue three wide, dropped down to the rail on the turn, had aim into the stretch but came up empty in the drive. STRAIGHT OUT three wide along the backstretch, came five wide around the turn, never threatened in the drive. HOTRAIL off a step slow then steadied after the start off heels, was rank losing his action into the turn while five wide, fell back through the stretch.
