FOR THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. Free nominations. \$200 to enter. Nominations close Wednesday, April 7, 2010. Purse will be \$75,000 guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 7th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Supplemental nominations of \$5,000 due at time of entry, all fees included. Entries close Wednesday April 14, 2010, by usual time of closing.

Weight: Three Year Old, 117 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes in 2010, allowed 3 lbs., non-winners of \$22,000 in 2010 allowed, 5 lbs. Field will be limited to ten starters with four on the alternate list. Preference to stakes winners in order (Grade I, Grade II, Grade III), stakes winners, then highest earnings in 2009-2010. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

JU JITSU JAX sat off the leaders three and four wide along the backstretch, was set down for the drive, closed under a furious rally the last sixteenth, split foes nearing the wire to be up in time. TRUST OR BUST alternated for the lead down the backstretch while three wide, lost some ground when THE JACKAL cut the corner sharply, came again to gain a momentary lead approaching the wire but could not hold off the winner's late charge. THE JACKAL alternated on the lead just off the rail, opened a clear lead into the stretch, dug in the last sixteenth to drop a close decision at the end in a very game effort. LOVE TO THE MAX off the pace five wide, tried to rally around the turn but could only make a mild gain in the lane. TAKEN with the leaders along the backstretch while four wide, lacked a closing bid when asked in the stretch. SEA DUBAI stalked the leaders from the rail, failed to respond in the drive. JOEY P. hopped then was off slow at the start, trailed along the inside.
