TAKELA SHAM rated close to the early pace two deep, took over nearing the half mile pole, was urged away rounding the final turn and widened slightly under steady stretch handling. ONEWILDRIVER settled well back from the early pace inside, angled out leaving the first turn, started a five wide bid approaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch six wide then lugged in while dueling for place. IMY'S BOY, off the pace inside, bid near the rail approaching the quarter pole then outfinished in the duel for place. KEY OF DUBAI rounded the opening turn about the four path, settled off the pace toward the outside, bid nearing the quarter pole, entered the stretch eight wide and finished evenly to pass tired rivals. ROADHOUSE ROMEO took a slim brief lead inside near the five eighths pole, was caught leaving the first turn, gave chase from that point then leveled off rounding the final turn. CRAFTY ROY rated close to the early pace four wide, gave chase from the three eighths pole then leveled off saving ground on the final turn. JAYGEES GEM, four wide the opening turn, raced well back toward mid track. MR BEAR was no factor saving ground. DANCING GOURMET raced wide early and broke down shortly after entering the backstretch.
