**Footnotes**

GAME ON DUDE prompted the pace in the three path around the first turn, pressed the pace two wide around the clubhouse turn, reached even terms nearing the half-mile pole, vied outside of PERCUSSION down the backstretch, put that foe away near the quarter pole, was immediately confronted by a three wide move from CLUBHOUSE RIDE, drifted out a bit turning for home, dug in between foes under left-handed urging through the lane and prevailed. CLUBHOUSE RIDE settled off the pace along the inside, advanced outside down the backstretch, bid three wide around the far turn, was slowly gaining outside of the winner through the lane and won the nod for the place. RON THE GREEK was bumped and pinched back soon after the start, raced well back in the two path through the opening three-quarters, moved three wide around the far turn, angled in in upper stretch, rallied along the rail and just missed second. PERCUSSION set a rated pace along the rail, vied inside of the winner down the backstretch and tired inside around the far turn. CAIXA ELETRONICA broke in and bumped RON THE GREEK just after the start, stalked the pace two wide and had no response when roused near the three-eighths pole. ISN'T HE PERFECT settled off pace while racing three wide, tired after three-quarters and was easing through the lane. THIS RACE WAS HAND TIMED.
