Footnotes

DOWN TOWN ALLEN rated a short lead inside, was let out a notch from the three eighths pole, asked for run from mid turn and dug in responsively to her rider's urging. AUTUMN AFFAIR rated close to the early pace off the rail, gave chase about the four path leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took place nearing the final turn but had no further gain through the stretch. RUNAWAY BRAE rated with the early pace two deep, gave chase past the three eighths pole, dropped back from the quarter, angled three wide into the lane and held on for show. RITA HAYWOOD settled off the pace toward the inside, gave chase past the three eighths pole, eased outward rounding the final turn, was carried further out entering the stretch then leveled off in the late going. CAT O' NINE TAILS charged the gate just as the starter hit the button, raced off the early pace toward mid track then saved some ground through the final turn. BAILEY BLUEYES raced well back toward mid track. OK LISTEN UP raced well back off the rail. LITTLE SHINEY raced well back outside.
