VANISHING WOLF set all the pace, rated well down the backstretch, held clear under a steady drive. SWEET AND WILD saved ground, rallied three wide on the turn to be clearly second best. AT EASE DIABLO stalked the pace from the inside but was no match for the top two. BLOOMIN JUSTICE pressed the pace between horses, lacked a late response. PRESS SCANDAL forced the leaders three and four wide, lacked the needed rally. DON'T DO IT hopped at the start then bumped with ANGELINE W, never was a factor. TANYA'S SONG never threatened inside. OLYMPIC GAL was used up after a half three wide. ANGELINE W bumped and steadied after the start, was outrun.
