SIGNATURE RUN chased the pace well back toward the outside, saved ground past the quarter pole then steadily advanced near the rail through the stretch to get up in late yards. GALLO, bumped at the break, chased the pace about the four path down the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, had the edge over the winner through most of the stretch and while up late for place, was outfinished for the win. SHILOH CREEK set a pressured pace inside and was under a hardy drive with the edge to late stretch before being overcome. CRUZIN BOP pressured the pace off the rail and held aim to late stretch before leveling off. DOCTOR J. chased the pace toward mid track to the head of the lane then weakened. PLEASE DON'T gave distant chase inside, steadied to avoid a fallen rival approaching the quarter pole and was not asked further. HEART BEEP broke out making contact with Gallo, gave distant chase off the rail then tripped and fell over a fallen rival approaching the quarter pole. ONE FAST FAMILY engaged in close early chase through most of the backstretch but broke down approaching the quarter pole. The stewards reviewed this race before declaring it official.
