Footnotes

CAROLINES STARLITE vied along the rail around the first turn, settled back inside early on the backstretch run, bid two wide from the three-sixteenths pole, reached near even terms in upper stretch, vied outside of ROCK N MARY and prevailed. ROCK N MARY set the pace three wide around the first turn, cleared past the three-eighths pole, set the pace along the rail around the far turn, dug in inside the winner in the stretch and gave way grudgingly. COULD BE A RUMOR was unruly behind the starting gate, hopped at the start, lacked speed three wide, advanced three wide around the far turn but was one-paced in the lane. HALF A NOTION chased the pace inside and came up empty while continuing on her left lead. ALLEN'S LAST DANCE was reluctant to load, bobbed at the start and never factored while racing four wide. NORMA THE STORMA dropped well back soon after the start and was never involved. BELIEVEINTHEPRIZE disputed the pace two wide and broke down leaving the three-eighths pole.
