Footnotes

WIN FOR ONE took the lead off the rail just inside the five eighths pole, rated the pace inside, came under pressure from the five sixteenths pole and held well with steady left hand encouragement through the lane. GATEWAY PARK came out making contact with Found Jewel leaving the gate, settled back inside, bid off the rail leaving the three eighths pole and finished evenly in place. FOUND JEWEL, pinched back at the start, rated off the pace inside, was pressured from the three eighths pole, eased three wide on the final turn and finished evenly to show. DON'T WORRY LOVE raced briefly clear early, stalked the pace at the rail past the five eighths pole, was asked for run toward the quarter then leveled out through the lane. VALLEY ROSE settled back toward the outside through the backstretch and showed little response on the final turn. ONE SWEET TART broke in making contact with Found Jewel, rated off the early pace about the three path, bid mildly leaving the three eighths pole but weakened in the stretch. CAT'S PUNCH was no factor while saving ground. FLO JO'S AFFAIR raced close to the early pace three wide though was through after a half mile. BANANA SKIN showed no speed widest.
