Footnotes

FORT DIX rated a short lead inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole, dueled with a slight disadvantage leaving the quarter pole, recovered control into the lane, exchanged light contact with Today And Always past the sixteenth pole but inched further ahead nearing the wire. TODAY AND ALWAYS stalked the pace off the rail, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to a slim lead into the final turn, lost some ground and the lead at the head of the lane, lugged inward to exchange light contact with the winner midstretch then leveled off approaching the wire. CHIGGER ROO settled off the early pace toward mid track, moved to contention leaving the first turn, gave chase from the three eighths pole, finished evenly and was gaining slowly. WINDSOR CITY chased the pace from the three path leaving the first turn, saved ground on the final turn, improved his position through the lane but was unsaddled on the turn and vanned off. AWESOME DAVID rated close inside the opening turn but showed no significant response down the backstretch. ROCK OUT settled back inside and had no rally. HE'S A PRIZE was pinched back early and not a factor. WESTERN SELECT angled in at the break, raced well back and was not a factor. BLAME IT ON BUSH rated close to the early pace then faded leaving the first turn. FIRSTIE was eased shortly after the

break, however, walked off. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of the runner-up, though found no cause for change.
