Footnotes

SEEKING MAGIC rated a slim lead inside, came under pressure toward the quarter pole and dug in under steady insistence to hold the edge. JAEGERMANN settled close to the pace inside, raced boxed at the winner's heels rounding the final turn, was driven close in deep stretch but ran out of ground. ARUMAGON rated close to his stable-mate off the rail, was pressured into the final turn, carried out entering the stretch then outfinished in the duel for place. BROOKS IN TOWN chased the pace about the three path and finished evenly four wide. BREAKING DAWN broke out making contact with Mr Bear, rated off the early pace four wide, made a mild bid through the backstretch then leveled off on the final turn. FLANK DA MAN raced well back inside early, eased out with a mild bid into the backstretch then weakened while saving ground on the final turn. SONNY CREWE JACK, unhurried early, eased outside with a bid leaving the half mile pole, moved close five wide on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. MR BEAR, bumped at the start, ran well back off the rail and was not a factor. HANDSOME JACK P chased the early pace about the four path but was through after the opening half mile.
