Footnotes

LOUANN'S BOOT was washy pre-race, reared and unseated his rider in the starting gate, quickly went clear, set the pace off the rail and held clear under a drive. CANTRUSHPERFECTION chased the winner from the inside around the first turn, edged closer down the backstretch, continued a slight gain in the three path around the far turn but was unable to seriously threatened the winner in the lane. NIMBLE TIGER settled off the pace while racing three wide, moved up a bit in the four path in tandem with CANTRUSHPERFECTION around the far turn, lost some ground coming five wide into the lane and was just up for the show. DR. BALIN was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced four wide around the far turn, angled in in upper stretch, quickly moved into third leaving the eighth pole but flattened out late and just lost the show. VALID RIDE (ARG) saved ground and failed to menace. STILL THE ONE never factored while racing three and four wide. TIME LIMIT was outrun while racing two wide.
