Footnotes

DEVORA stalked the early pace four wide, rallied to the front past the five sixteenths pole and dug in under a hardy stretch drive to inch clear. WATCH AND WONDER rated a slim early lead three wide, yielded control past the five sixteenths pole, continued in close chase from there, leveled off late but managed to retain place. MEG'S MONSTER BABY stalked the pace inside, eased three wide leaving the turn and was gaining slowly on the waning runner-up. FOREVER TO BE chased the early pace from the inside, angled four wide into the stretch and finished well. MISS HANNA ROSE chased the early pace two deep while between horses, dropped back toward the quarter pole and leveled off. CREDIT RISK engaged in close early chase five wide but faded past the three eighths pole. BLUE RIDGE CONCERN broke a step slow and quickly lost contact. QUIET LORRAINE was never a factor while saving ground and hit the rail past the three sixteenths pole.
