EL PISTON settled back about the three path, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, steadily improved rounding the final turn, took the lead in midstretch and used as necessary to widen. NEXT PAGE, four wide early, rated close about the three path, closed to contention leaving the five sixteenths pole, contested the final turn two deep, caught the pacesetter in midstretch but was no match for the winner. TROUBLE MAKIN rated back inside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole, eased out through the upper stretch and was just up to show in an even finish. HONKY TONK MOON moved to a clear lead to rate the pace inside, maintained the edge rounding the final turn, was under pressure from the top of the stretch, yielded control nearing the sixteenth pole, bobbled at that point and weakened from there. LONG SHADOW raced well back off the rail. TINKER was kept off the early pace inside, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, showed no significant response to the head of the lane and weakened. MAIN MAN SAM raced well back and was not a factor.
