SARDIS broke alertly and quickly angled to the rail, dictated the pace, drew clear in the stretch. OLYMPIC NIGHT three wide on the first turn, pressed the pace, held the place. SIMON SLEW was slow early, found her best stride late. RICO ENDS WELL always close up, faded late. UNIQUE TECHNIQUE in good position to the stretch, weakened. SHESANOTHERGRUMP lacked speed, improved position. PEACOMB HEN always midpack, had no rally. TALKING POINT stumbled at the start, trailed to the stretch, never reached contention. CARNI'S LUCK in good position to the far turn, tired. ROCKIN ROY failed to respond in a lackluster outing.
