Footnotes

WAVE ME BY was caught five wide around the first turn, angled in to the two path the first time through the stretch, eased out to advance three wide around the far turn then slowly wore down his foes in the lane to get up in deep stretch. STILL THE ONE prompted the pace three wide through the opening half, bid two wide down the backstretch, took the lead near the quarter pole, vied outside of IM A TIGGER TOO around the far turn, led to deep stretch but could not resist the winner. DUSTIN MILLIE pressed the pace two wide between rivals, dropped back along the rail into the far turn then finished willingly between foes to re-gain the show. IM A TIGGER TOO set the pace along the rail, was collared near the quarter pole, continued to vie inside past the sixteenth pole then weakened. GAS HOUSE brushed with STEAMROLLER BLUES after the start, raced in the two path, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. ONLY BY INVITATION was bumped after the start, raced three and four wide and lacked the needed rally. DEVIL'S DREAM stalked the pace from the rail and faded after a half. WARRIOR PROSPECT was never a factor while racing three wide. STEAMROLLER BLUES was brushed after the start, saved ground early, raced three wide around the far turn and lacked a bid. KEEPASHARPLOUKOUT made little impact while racing three wide.
