CARVEY raced quickly clear to set the pace inside, came under mild hand pressure past the quarter pole then dug in to steady stretch handling to widen. LOVE TO BE IN DEBT came away awkwardly, chased the winner off the rail, lost momentum at the rail rounding the turn but dug in through the lane to be second best. A AND E UPGRADE engaged in close chase about the three path then leveled off through the lane. LADY E gave close chase off the rail through the backstretch but dropped back rounding the turn and leveled off in the lane. EMPEROR'S ROBE saved ground. GREATEST MOMENT chased the pace from the outside then weakened in the five path of the turn. ROCK BUSTER, a step slow to break, was not a factor well off the rail. ABBRUZZO, also a step slow at the break, trailed the field saving ground.
