WILD JERSEY BOY hit the gate then was squeezed back just after the start, rallied three wide to take the lead at the quarter pole, vied outside of BLICKENSTAFF around the turn then drove clear in upper stretch. MY PLEIADES stalked the leaders in the two path into the turn, swung five wide at the head of the lane and finished strongly. BLICKENSTAFF dueled outside of PLEAD MY CASE for the early lead, put away that rival entering the turn, vied inside of the winner around the turn then was outfinished in the lane. SIR FRANK forced the issue three and four wide, lacked the needed closing bid while racing on his left lead through the lane. DR. SPOCK stumbled after the start, moved up inside around the turn, eased three wide entering the stretch, angled back toward the rail in mid stretch and finished with good energy. HE'S THE KING raced five wide around the turn and rallied belatedly. ROBB TRADD failed to menace. PLEAD MY CASE set a pressured pace along the rail, tired nearing the turn. SPORTS BAR was no factor.
