Footnotes

UNUSUAL MANNER dueled outside of Smokey Fella, cleared that rival leaving the three sixteenths pole and drew off under a drive through the lane. WATCH TOWER settled off the duel down the backstretch, advanced in the two path around the turn and rallied for the place. MANDATUM was out sprinted down the backstretch, saved ground around the turn, angled out in upper stretch and finished strongly. SMOKEY FELLA dueled inside of the winner and tired in the drive. MR. COMMISSIONER threw his head as the gates opened and was off slow, angled four wide nearing the lane and passed tiring rivals. HOLD THE LINE raced along the rail and lacked a closing bid. COOPER JUNIOR failed to menace while racing three wide.
