NAVY SEAL stalked the pace two wide down the backstretch, reached near even terms by the three-sixteenths pole, vied outside to upper stretch and drove clear leaving the eighth pole. ROCK N HEART chased the pace two wide, drifted five wide turning for home and finished well. CAPTAIN KIRKLAND was out sprinted down the backstretch, raced three wide around the turn, was carried six wide turning for home and rallied on his left lead. TOY STORE lacked speed, raced two wide around the turn and rallied belatedly. YOUNG MONEY set the pace along the rail, vied inside of the the winner from the three-sixteenths pole to upper stretch and weakened through the lane. STERLING BLACKJACK never factored while racing four wide. OUR HALF steadily faded two wide.
