COUNTER MOVE dueled two wide to the quarter pole, drew clear around the far turn, held clear past the sixteenth pole and lasted under a steady drive. TIN PAN ALLEY CAT rated off the duel along the inside, angled three wide midway around the far turn, rallied well but could not catch the winner. WYATT'S HOPE was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced four wide around the far turn and was along for the show. A KISS IN THE PARK lagged inside, swung out nearing the eighth pole and had a mild belated rally. NOSTALGIC BID dueled inside of the winner and tired around the far turn. BURNT OFFERING stalked the pace two and three wide and came up empty.
