TRES CHIC settled off the early pace off the rail, surged to the front three wide approaching the seven sixteenths pole, maintained an edge to the middle of the final turn, was urged clear from there, lost ground into the lane and dug in under steady encouragement to widen. MY REWARD stalked the pace three wide, bid leaving the three eighths pole, moved to the inside approaching the final turn and had aim at the head of the lane before leveling off. PASSIONATE SPEAKER, bumped at the break, stalked the early pace four wide, gave chase from the three eighths pole and had close aim on the final turn before weakening. MOON DROP, unhurried inside, eased out with a bid from the three eighths pole and improved position to late stretch before running out of ground. AUDREY THERESA stalked the early pace in mid track, bid nearing the quarter pole, saved ground on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. PAY NO MIND brushed the gate at the start and raced well back. I GOT A ANSWER was never a factor. CLOSING SCENE moved to a short lead inside the five eighths pole, gave chase from the seven sixteenths then faded toward the final turn. WERBLIN PHONE stumbled outward making contact with Passionate Speaker leaving the gate, quickly recovered stride to take a short early lead, dropped back past the five eighths pole, continued in stalking position to the seven sixteenths pole then faded.
