**Footnotes**

EXPECT RAIN broke awkwardly, rated along the rail around the first turn, advanced outside down the backstretch, rallied four wide around the far turn, drew abreast of WE DID IT near the three-sixteenths pole, vied outside of that rival past the sixteenth pole, drifted out throughout the stretch and prevailed under a long drive. WE DID IT dueled inside of DEFREREST BURN around the first turn, was content to drop back down the backstretch, ranged up to reclaim the lead leaving the quarter pole, battled inside the winner from the three-sixteenths pole to deep stretch and just missed in a game effort. SAIGON TIGER lacked speed, saved ground around the first turn, moved up five wide around the far turn, swung wider in upper stretch and closed strongly through the lane. DECK THE HALL stalked the leaders while racing just off the rail, edged closer while continuing to save ground around the far turn, lacked the needed rally in the lane. MARQUET RISE prompted the pace four wide, lacked a late response. DEFREREST BURN set a pressured pace while racing in the two path around the first turn, opened a clear lead down the backstretch then gave way approaching the quarter pole. RUGGED CROSS was no factor. LAUSANNE PACT failed to menace. SISTER JANE never threatened while racing four wide. KETTLE RUN flashed brief speed three wide.
